These sectors provide livelihood to over 25 million fishers and fish farmers at the primary level, doubling the number along the value chain. Fish is an affordable and excellent source of quality animal protein, a good avenue to reduce hunger and malnutrition in the country. Indian fisheries sector has evolved gradually over the years and became an important tool for socio-economic upliftment. India is the second largest fish producing country and accounts for about 16% of total inland and 5% of total global marine fish production respectively. In 2021-22, India's total fish production stood at 162.48 lakh tons, which included 121.21 lakh tons and 41.27 lakh tons from inland and marine sectors, respectively. Fisheries sector plays a crucial role in the national economy and is one of the key contributors to the country's foreign exchange earnings. However, the sector is facing challenges due to climate change, pollution, water abstraction, loss of biodiversity, over-fishing, unmanaged aquaculture expansion, etc. Conservation and sustainable use of these resources is a prime challenge in the context of global climate change. Against this backdrop, the present forum will discuss and direct Indian fisheries and aquaculture for attaining Sustainable Development Goals.

ICAR-Central Inland Fisheries Research Institute (ICAR-CIFRI)

ICAR-CIFRI is the first Institute established in India in the field of inland fisheries research, extension and training, which has been celebrating its 75 years of dedicated service to the nation. AFSIB Awards

Young Scientist Award: Eligibility: Scientists and Research Scholars below the age of 35 years (as on 30 November 2023) working in the field of fisheries related disciplines. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 3000/- and a citation (up to 10 awards).

Prof. H. P. C Shetty Award: Eligibility: Persons involved in fisheries research and development, below 50 years as on 30 November 2023. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 25,000/- a medallion and an invitation to deliver keynote address at the Forum.













Professors T. J. Pandian and A. J. Matty Award: Eligibility: Applicant should be below 35 years (40 years in the case of women) as on 30 November 2023, preferably carried out his/her work in India and has worked towards aquaculture development through research. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 15,000, a medallion and an invitation to deliver keynote address at the forum.

Dr. Pillay Aquaculture Award: Eligibility: Outstanding work on any aspect of aquaculture (research/extension/development) carried out in India by an individual, group or organization (government or private). The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 25,000/-, a citation and invitation to deliver keynote address during the forum.

Dr. M. C. Nandeesha Award: This award is for the best innovation by a fish farmer which has helped to improve productivity of the culture systems. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 25,000/- and a citation.

Shri J. V. H. Dixitulu National Award: Eligibility: Outstanding contributions in the field of fisheries extension/ communication in India by individuals/institutions/ NGOs. The award will carry a memento, a citation, cash award of Rs. 15,000 and invitation to present the work at the forum.

IFSI Awards

To felicitate achievements and accomplishments, selected outstanding students, professors, researchers, industries, and scientists will be honoured with the following awards for their significant contribution in the field of fisheries science.

Best Presentation Award: The best presentation made by a young scientist (up to 35 years) and a senior scientist (above 35 years) will be awarded with a medal and a scroll.

Best Poster Presentation Award: The best poster will be awarded a medal and a scroll.

IFSI Gold Medal for the distinguished researchers: IFSI will felicitate distinguished researchers in the field of fisheries science with medals instituted in the name of Late Dr. Hiralal Choudhury, Padma Shri Dr. S. Ayyappan, Dr. J. K. Jena and Prof. A. P. Sharma. For these gold medals, eligible researchers may send three copies of their biodata and full paper of the work they intend to present at the Forum, in an envelope to the address 'Inland Fisheries Society of India, ICAR-CIFRI, Barrackpore-700120, Kolkata, West Bengal'. Please note to write 'Application for IFSI Gold Medals' on the envelope. The document should reach IFSI, ICAR-CIFRI, Barrackpore on or before 30 November 2023. The eligibility criteria for the awards are given below;

Dr. Hiralal Choudhury Gold Medal: Eligibility: Age above 45 years (as on 30 November 2023) and possessing at least 10 years of research experience, made sustained and significant contribution in fisheries and allied sector. The award consists of a medal and a scroll.

Padma Shri Dr. S. Ayyappan Gold Medal: Eligibility: Age between 35-45 years (as on 30 November 2023), must have made meritorious contribution in the field of fisheries and allied sector. The award consists of a medal and a scroll.













Dr. J. K. Jena Young Scientist Award: Eligibility: Age below 35 years (as on 30 November 2023), having meritorious background with significant contribution in fisheries and allied sector. The award consists of a medal and a scroll.

Prof. A. P. Sharma Young Scientist Award: Eligibility: Age below 35 years (as on 30 November 2023), having meritorious background with significant contribution in fisheries and allied sector. The award consists of a medal and a scroll.

Who Should Attend?

The 13th IFAF, 2024 is designed for fisheries professionals and companies, innovative farmers, entrepreneurs, youth with ideas, academicians, scientists, researchers, students, research institutions, government officials, policymakers, and others engaged in activities related to education, research, business, and entrepreneurship in fisheries and aquaculture.

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

Authors should submit the abstract in Times New Roman font 12 with double spacing with a margin of at least 2.5 cm on all sides of the page. Characters/words count should not exceed 250. The names of all the authors should be mentioned after the title in italics. Please provide e-mail id and phone number of presenting author along with affiliations. Please mark asterisk (*) for the name of presenting author (Name in Bold). The abstract should be followed by 4-5 keywords relevant to the research work mentioned in the abstract. Authors must mention the theme under which they are submitting the abstract. For preventing discrepancies in page layout, the document file should preferably in word 2010, or onward file format. All abstracts are to be submitted via official mail id:13ifaf.cifri@gmail.com on or before 30 November 2023.

Proceedings of the seminar will be published in the form of a Book/Journal. Authors are requested to prepare their full-length paper as per the guidelines of the Journal of Inland Fisheries Society of India.
